

Student Career Experience Program

Full or Part Time Opportunities for Current Students Only

This program provides experience that is directly related to the student's educational program and curriculum and career goals. This program provides for a schedule of periods of attendance at an accredited school combined with periods of career-related work in this agency. The work experience MUST be related to his/her academic/career goals. The student must at least be a high school graduate. The Student Career Experience Program is a formally structured program and requires a written agreement by all parties (agency, school, and student) as to the nature of work assignments; schedule of work assignments and class attendance; evaluation procedures, and requirements for continuation and successful completion of the program. After student completes degree requirements, they may be eligible for conversion to a career appointment.

Students appointed under this program are entitled to earn annual and sick leave, holiday pay; health and life insurance, and retirement coverage.

The qualification requirements vary depending on the career field. The qualification standards are found in the Qualifications Standards Handbook Operating Manual, which is published by the U.S. Office of Personnel Management.
