**TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:** The Wilmington District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) has completed an Environmental Assessment (EA)/Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI) for the John H. Kerr Reservoir Aquatic Vegetation Management Program, John H. Kerr Reservoir. The EA addressed the environmental impacts associated with the Implementation of the Kerr Reservoir Aquatic Vegetation Management Program (AVMP). The FONSI has been prepared in accordance with the Council on Environmental Quality and USACE regulations for implementing the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA)(33 CFR 230), as amended.

This Notice of Availability is being distributed to notify known interested persons of the availability of the FONSI. This completes the NEPA process for this action. The EA and FONSI may be accessed online at:
