





# Migration

Resident– Lives locally year round

Short migrant– Short distance migrant (may travel a few hundred to several hundred miles for the winter).

Neo-tropic– Travels long distances to tropical areas of the Americas for winter.



Wildlife notices your intrusion on their habitat; find a spot to relax and be quiet for 5-10 minutes letting your presence pass. Wildlife will gradually go about their business when they see you are not a threat.
