Kerr 216, provided additional information in response to concerns raised on the need to address the costs of likely alternatives that would be evaluated during the feasibility study phase and the differences between costs and scheduling information in the justification sheet and the subject report.

2. The subject analysis and letter of intent, as supplemented by additional information referenced in paragraph 1.b, are approved for proceeding into the feasibility phase of planning. The district should plan to convene an in-progress review meeting early in the feasibility study to ensure that the study is focused and tailored to meet specific objectives. Based on the results of the in-progress review meeting, the project study plan may need to be revised to better define depth of analysis required and/or refine study constraints.

3. Submission of the model feasibility cost sharing agreement is not required, provided no deviations are required.
