## **Ramsey Selected as W. Kerr Scott Lake Operations Manager**

**WILMINGTON, North Carolina**, August 30—“We are pleased to announce that Mr. Terry A. Ramsey has been selected as the new Operations Manager for W. Kerr Scott Lake,” said Jim Butler, Chief of Operations for the Wilmington District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. “Terry has long experience with our district, and served as Acting Operations Manager at Scott after the retirement of long-time Operations Manager Andy Duncan.” Ramsey will officially assume his new duties on September 22.

Ramsey has served as Assistant Operations Manager at the John H. Kerr Dam and Reservoir in Boydton, Virginia, since 1995. During that time, he has acted as Operations Manager at both Kerr Lake and Scott Lake.

His previous assignments include stints as the Supervisory Park Ranger and Project Forester at Kerr Lake, Park Ranger at Huntington District’s John W. Flannagan Reservoir, and as a Forest Technician with the Jefferson and Kisatchi National Forests. He holds a Bachelor of Science Degree from Virginia Tech, and has done postgraduate study at Slippery Rock University in Pennsylvania. He is a Registered Forester in the State of North Carolina.

During his career with Wilmington District, Mr. Ramsey has been recognized with a number of awards and has served on several task forces that addressed such issues as user fees, visitor and ranger safety, and land use. He served on the Hurricane Andrew Recovery Team in 1992 and the National Boy Scout Jamboree Team in 1985.
