## Corps Requires Registration to Receive Public Notices

Wilmington, NC– The Wilmington District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, intends to compile a new master list of recipients for Regulatory Program Public Notices. We will revise the Public Notice mailing list to remove outdated and duplicate entries and to streamline the public notice distribution process to better serve you. There are additional benefits of an email-based distribution service, such as reduction of paper, energy conservation, and cost savings of public funds. You can also easily review and delete any unwanted email notices without contributing to the waste stream.

On December 1, 2007, the Wilmington District Corps Regulatory Program will no longer use the existing mailing lists to distribute Public Notices. **You must register for our new mailing list if you wish to begin or continue to receive Public Notices from the Wilmington District Corps Regulatory Program.** You may do this at any time. We will maintain the new list so you may add, change or unsubscribe to the list at any time.

Please access our online form (<http://www.saw.usace.army.mil/WETLANDS/notices/PublicNotice.asp>) to sign up to receive Public Notices from the Wilmington District Regulatory Program. You may also print out and mail us this form if this is more convenient. All individuals or groups interested in receiving public notices from us should provide an email address that we can use to send the notices of interest. If you do not have email access, we will continue to mail out notices on a limited, by request only basis.

Note that we will also no longer maintain single county distribution lists, and we will no longer maintain any special public notice list other than the five listed: (Four Field Office Mailing Lists): Asheville, Raleigh, Washington, Wilmington, and All NC Actions. For example, if you want to obtain CAMA actions, you must subscribe to the Washington and Wilmington Field Office mailing list as we will no longer maintain a separate CAMA mailing list. The attachment to this Public Notice has the current list of the counties administered by each Field Office.
