PHILPOTT LAKE FEE AREA CAMPING REGULATIONS

Welcome to GOOSE POINT! The Corps of Engineers has contracted park attendants in an effort to provide a secure and pleasant visit for you. Your observance of the following policies and regulations is appreciated:

- 1. Alcoholic beverages and firearms are prohibited in all park areas and all regulations are strictly enforced.
- 2. Peak Season Camping Fees (April 1-October 31st)
 Nightly Rates
 Non-electric Sites \$26.00
 (35-44) Loop B

Electric/Water Sites \$34.00 (1-34) Loop C, (45-54, 57-63) Loop A Double-Site 55/56 \$68.00

The maximum number of individuals per single family campsite is limited to six (exception is a core family in which the parent(s) plus children under 18 years of age exceed six individuals). Two vehicles are permitted per site, any additional vehicles will be charged an Extra Vehicle Fee (\$7.00/vehicle/day) when parking is available. Senior/Access cardholders may receive 50% discount for extra vehicle fee.

- 3. The parking of vehicles, boat trailers, placement of camping equipment, etc. outside the assigned paved or gravel portion of the campsite is prohibited.
- 4. You will be issued a camp fee receipt and a camp pass, which are to be displayed as directed by the park attendant. Camp passes should be returned to the park attendant upon departure or at the 2 PM checkout time. Check in time is at 3 PM.
- 5. Please dispose of all your trash in dumpsters located in the park. Failure to do so is a violation of Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations. You are encouraged to deposit aluminum cans in the bins provided.

- 6. The park campground gate is locked between the hours of 10 PM and 6 AM. All campground visitors must depart the camp area by 10 PM. Exit gates will open automatically upon departure. Gate codes will be given to registered campers for after hour park access.
- 7. Fires must be confined to designated fireplaces and extinguished when unattended or vacated.
- 8. A fee of \$7.00 per vehicle is charged for visitors to campsites. Registered campers are limited to 2 additional visitor vehicles depending on available parking. The maximum number of individuals permitted per site is ten including visitors.
- 9. Pets are not permitted on the beach or in the swim area. All pets must be on a leash no longer than six feet.
- 10. Quiet hours shall be observed between the hours of 10 PM and 6 AM.
