- 1. Applicants need to contact an area ranger or call the visitor center for information at 434-738-6143.
- 2. Ranger will provide an application.
- 3. Allow up to 90 days for review once a completed application is received.
- 4. If approved, the area may need to be replanted on 25 x 25 tree spacing.
- 5. Approved applicants must guarantee the survival of sod, grass mixtures, and replanted trees for five years.

Erosion Control Considerations

- 1. Ranger determines that erosion threatens your private property line.
- 2. Bank of the shoreline has eroded 3 feet or higher and has insufficient natural rock.
- 3. Property is on the main channel or has a very steep bank.
- 4. Stabilization will minimize a silt deposition problem in the reservoir.
- 5. Minimal trees will be removed to perform the work.
