

W KERR SCOTT LAKE, US ARMY CORPS OF ENGINEERS (USACE), FIREARMS SAFETY INFORMATION

W Kerr Scott Lake and the surrounding federal property are under the stewardship of the US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE). The possession and discharge of firearms for the purposes of hunting and fishing (bow fishing) are authorized in certain areas.

The possession and discharge of firearms on federal property at W Kerr Scott Lake are subject to the following:

36 CFR 327.13 Explosives, firearms, other weapons and fireworks (a) *The possession of loaded firearms, ammunition, loaded projectile firing devices, bows and arrows, crossbows, or other weapons is prohibited unless: (1) In the possession of a Federal, state or local law enforcement officer; (2) Being used for hunting or fishing, with devices being unloaded when transported to, from or between hunting and fishing sites. (3) Being used at authorized shooting ranges;*

- **USACE Firearms Safety Zone Restriction** - The discharge of firearms, projectile firing devices, bows and arrows, crossbows, or other weapons within, into, or across designated Firearms Safety Zones is prohibited.

- Safety Zones are enforced under 36 CFR 327.12 Restrictions (a).
- The safety zone extends 100 yards (300 feet) from the shoreline.
- The safety zone restriction prohibits the discharge of firearms.
- The safety zone restriction does not prohibit the transport of firearms in compliance with 36 CFR 327.13 (a)(2).

- Firearms are prohibited inside federal facilities except for those in the possession of Federal, state, or local law enforcement officers.

- **Fort Hamby Archery Course** - The use of archery equipment for target practice is authorized at the Archery Course in compliance with course rules. The course is for archery only. There are no other authorized firearms shooting ranges at W Kerr Scott Lake.
