All interested parties are herby advised that the Wilmington District, Corps of Engineers (Corps) is **extending the commenting period** on the Draft Environmental Impact Statement for the project, known as Village of Bald Head Island Shoreline Protection Project, that plans to install a 1,900-ft terminal groin structure as well as creation and maintenance of an updrift sand fillet on the western end of South Beach, on Bald Head Island, in Brunswick County, North Carolina. This notice amends our January 10, 2014 Public Notice seeking comments on the project and extends the commenting period to March 17, 2014. A Public Hearing for the DEIS will be held at the International Longshoreman's Association Hall, located at 211 West 10th Street in Southport, NC on March 4, 2014, at 6:00 pm.
