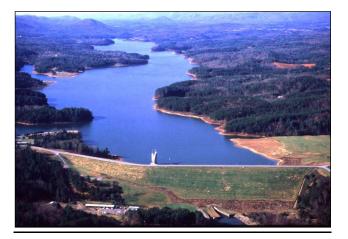


W. Kerr Scott Dam and Reservoir, NC (O&M)

FY 2023 Planned Actions:

- Operate and maintain recreation facilities to meet continued public demand
- Operate and maintain dam infrastructure for flood risk management
- Environmental stewardship of the property

- 1. AUTHORIZATION: Flood Control Act of 1946 (PL 79-526).
- 2. LOCATION AND DESCRIPTION: The W. Kerr Scott Dam and Reservoir is located on the Yadkin River about 6 miles upstream from Wilkesboro, North Carolina. At full flood pool elevation (1,075 feet mean sea level), the reservoir extends 15.7 miles upstream to the Wilkes-Caldwell County line. The project consists of a rolled earth-fill dam 1,740 feet long with top of dam about 148 feet above the streambed elevation. There is also a spillway near the north abutment of the dam in a rock cut with a crest elevation of 1,075 feet and an outlet works consisting of an intake structure, control tower, and a circular concrete conduit 12.25 feet in diameter through the base of the dam near the south abutment. The reservoir has a gross capacity of 153,000 acre-feet of which 112,000 acre-feet are reserved for flood risk management, 33,000 acre-feet will be used as required for water supply, and 8,000 acre-feet being contained in the minimum pool.
- 3. <u>FY 2022 FEDERAL FUNDING ALLOCATION</u>: \$5,045,000. This includes \$4,025,000 in President's Budget funding and \$1,020,000 in FY 2022 Bipartisan Infrastructure Law funds.
- 4. <u>FY 2023 FEDERAL FUNDING ALLOCATION</u>: \$7,710,000. President's Budget funding (\$4,010,000) will be used for normal operation and maintenance of the project. Bipartisan Infrastructure Law funds in the amount of \$3,700,000 are being used for the project office siding replacement (\$200,000), construction of a new maintenance compound (\$2.000.000), control tower bridge lead paint removal (\$500,000), and placement of rip rap on the face of the dam and erosion control on spillway (\$1,000,000).

5. **FY 2024 PRESIDENT'S BUDGET:** \$5,040,000. Funds will be used for normal operation and maintenance of the project. Funds in the amount of \$531,000 could be used for the following project activities:
