PUBLIC NOTICE

Corps of Engineers seek public comments on Raleigh Executive Jetport

WILMINGTON, N.C. - The Wilmington District, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has received an application from the Raleigh Executive Jetport seeking Department of the Army authorization to permanently impact 138 linear feet of intermittent stream channel and 0.48 acre of headwater forested wetlands, associated with construction of hangars, aircraft parking apron, vehicle parking areas, taxiway connector, and associated stormwater improvements, at the existing facility in Sanford, Lee County, North Carolina.

The Corps of Engineers is soliciting comments from the public to compare alternatives that have been carried forward for detailed study pursuant to applicable procedures of Section 404 of the Clean Water Act. To make this decision, comments are used to assess impacts on endangered species, historic properties, water quality, general environmental effects and all other appropriate public interest factors. Comments are used in the preparation of an Environmental Assessment (EA) and/or an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). Comments are also used to determine the need for a public hearing and to determine the overall public interest of the proposed activity.
